The latest pottery types found in Bc53 are those representative of the late Pueblo II and early Pueblo III periods. Among these are Chaco Corrugated, Chaco B on W, and trade wares from Arizona, other parts of New Mexico, and southern Colorado. The trade wares, all typical of the Pueblo III period, are Wingate B on R, Mesa Verde B on W, McElmo B on W, Red Mesa B on W, Forestdale Smudged, Puerco B on R, Upper Gila Corrugated, and Deadman's B on W.

The fact that Chaco Corrugated ware appears in the bottom level of the strat block establishes beyond a doubt that Bc53 occupation started in the late Pueblo II period and extended into the early Pueblo III period. The high percentages of Pueblo III trade wares in the upper levels bears out this conclusion.
