Cut from a cliff and used as a medicine stone by Hastine Kli a Navajo. Chaco Cañon, N.M. Purchased by A.Hrdlicka. Found by Mr. R.E. Dodge (Aug. 8", 1901) near the rim-rock on the S. Side of Chaco Cañon, N.M. opposite P. Bonito, N.M. Probably used during ye-be-chai in Oct. 1900.

No. 12842 Navajo Dice (5) Navajo.

"Tsin Takah" made by the Navajos for a trader at Thorran, N.M. Obtained Aug. 1901.
